**Q. 65. What is a disorderly house?**

A. A disorderly house is a licensed premises that **disturbs** the neighborhood or is maintained for purposes which are **injurious to the public morals, health, convenience or safety**. For example, a licensed outlet that (a) disturbs the neighborhood with noise, loud music, loitering, littering, vandalism, urination or defecation by patrons, graffiti, etc.; or (b) **has many crimes ongoing inside**, such as **drunks, fights, assaults, prostitution, narcotics**, etc. The licensed premises **includes the parking lot**. **Any licensee, or employee of any licensee, who keeps or permits such a disorderly house is guilty of a misdemeanor, and the license is subject to disciplinary action. (Sections 25601 and 24200)**
